



## 2017/18 PROGENY COMPETITION

### Promoting Productivity

#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries limited to members of Holstein Friesian New Zealand residing in New Zealand.
- **SECTIONS**  
**There are two sections, Senior and Junior with THREE prize winners in each section.**  
**Senior Team** is made up of **five** daughters from one sire. Daughters to be *older* than two years and six months at calving and have calved and been tested in the 2016 or 2017 calendar year. (Senior teams may include one Junior.)
  - All cows not previously classified must be in-milk at the time of inspection (Oct 2017 – Feb 2018). Cows must have been milked at the normal time.
  - For previously classified cows that are dry at the time of inspection, the udder and classification score from their last classification will be used to determine type points.**Junior Team** is made up of **four** daughters from one sire. Daughters to be *under* two years and six months at the time of calving, and be in-milk at the time of inspection (Oct 2017 – Feb 2018).
- **COW QUALIFICATIONS** – Entries must be registered Holstein Friesian with a minimum of F12. All animals in a team must be owned by one family and milked in the same herd.
- **SIRE QUALIFICATIONS** – The sire of the team must be a registered Holstein Friesian.
- **VERIFICATION** – The office will verify all animals through the national database but registration reports & certificates must be available to confirm the identity and ancestry of all entries.
- All results are available for publication.

#### CALCULATION OF POINTS

##### 1. TYPE POINTS

Calculated by using the udder score between four and nine and the classification between 81 and 90 given by the Classifier while carrying out TOP inspections scheduled from October 2017 to February 2018. **Therefore, all animals must be submitted for classification or, if previously classified, be available for inspection in the year in which the competition is held. They will be re-assessed for competition entry.**

- a) **Udder Score**  
3 points for each udder overall score above four (max 15pts)
- b) **Overall Award**  
3.5pts for each classification over 80 (max 35pts)

81 = 3.5pts	85 = 17.5pts	89 = 31.5pts
82 = 7pts	86 = 21pts	EX = 35pts
83 = 10.5pts	87 = 24.5pts	
84 = 14pts	88 = 28pts	

##### 2. PRODUCTION POINTS

(Taken from database as at the first AE Run in April following classification tours.)

- a) **Production Worth** – 1 point for every 8 PW points above \$0 to a maximum of \$200 (max 25pts)
- b) **Protein BV** – 1 point for every 2kg of Protein BV above 0kg to a maximum of 50kg of Protein BV

Animals may be substituted at the time of inspection - i.e. for ill health, death.
