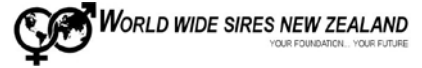




World Wide Sires Protein Awards



Awarded to the two-year-old, three-year-old, four-year-old, and five-years-and-over cows with the highest kg protein production.

General:

Entries: Automatically processed in the office

Presented at: AGM

Conditions:

1. This competition is open to all registered females with a minimum F12 prior to the commencement of the seasons lactation.
2. Females to have calved during the appropriate calendar year (ie. if the competition is for the 2014-15 season, then the cow/heifer must have calved during 2014 etc.
3. The top protein producer for each age group (two-year-old, three-year-old, four-year-old, and five-years-and-over) will be deemed the winner of the award for that age group.
4. Protein production is measured in kg of protein produced within the season in question.
5. Production is taken from the latest full production records — usually run in August of each year to ensure a complete lactation is recorded on database for each registered animal.
6. All results are available for publication.
